

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-03

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE VOLCANO
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT CONCERNING WATER RATES**

AND RATIONING

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Volcano Community Services District
("District") as follows:

SECTION ONE: AMENDMENT TO WATER RATES.

The charges for water service furnished to customers within the District shall be in the amount(s) set forth in the attached "Water Rate Structure" schedules, which are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION TWO: AMENDMENT TO EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE NO. 2000-02

The effective date for the charges for water service furnished to customers within the District pursuant to Ordinance No. 2000-02 shall be changed from August 1, 2000 to July 1, 2000.

SECTION THREE: INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS.

To the extent that the terms and provisions of this Ordinance may be inconsistent or in conflict with the terms and conditions of any prior District ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation governing the same subject, the terms of this Ordinance shall prevail with respect to the subject matter thereof, and such inconsistent and conflicting provisions of prior ordinances, resolutions, rules or regulations are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, no other provision of this Ordinance shall be affected thereby.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE.

The water service charges set forth in Section One shall be effective as of September 1, 2000, and the water service charges set forth in Ordinance No. 2000-02 shall be effective from July 1 through August 31, 2000, as determined by the District Board of Directors at its September 11, 2000 meeting.

SECTION SIX: POSTING.

The District Secretary is directed to post a copy of this Ordinance in three (3) public places in the District within ten (10) days after its adoption.

The VCSD Board of Directors has determined that a water rate increase is necessary and inevitable. The VCSD Board of Directors will consider passing and ordinance at the December 2, 2002 meeting to enact a rate increase that will become effective on January 1, 2002. The proposed rate increase is as follows: The base will be increased to \$28.00 and the usage charges will remain the same: tier 1 \$1.25 per 1,000 gallons for usage less than 10,000 gallons, tier 2 will be \$2.25 per 1,000 gallons for usage between 10,000 and 15,000 gallons, and tier 3 will be \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons for usage over 15,000 gallons.
